1	Remove cap from nozzle that meter to be installed on.		
2	Install <b>METER</b> and tighten using <b>ONLY</b> an approved hydrant wrench. Make sure meter faces up & gate valve does not interfere with hydrant operation.		
3	Make sure caps on unused nozzles are tight.		
4	Install <b>BACKFLOW DEVICE</b> on end of <b>METER</b> and tighten with approved hydrant wrench.		
5	Install <b>JACK STAND</b> provided under <b>BACKFLOW DEVICE</b> .		
6	Attach hose from backflow device to truck.		
7	Make sure all valves on truck are open.		
8	Open gate valve on meter just enough to allow air to escape.		
9	Open hydrant <b>SLOWLY</b> , hydrant <b>MUST</b> be fully open to operate properly.		
10	Use gate valve on meter to regulate flow ( <b>DO NOT USE HYDRANT ITSELF OR BALL VALVES ON BACKFLOW DEVICE</b> ) to regulate flow.		
11	After truck is full, <b>SLOWLY</b> close gate valve on meter to stop flow.		
12	After gate valve is closed, close hydrant all the way, gate valve leaks. <b>DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN HYDRANT.</b>		
13	When returning to hydrant to fill again the same day, open gate valve to let air out and open hydrant <b>SLOWLY</b> , repeat as before.		
14	Remove meter from hydrant at end of day.

**AGREEMENT FOR USE OF A FIRE HYDRANT FOR BULK WATER SALES  
CENTRAL WELD COUNTY WATER DISTRICT**

Central Weld County Water District ("District") is the owner of facilities for the purpose of furnishing treated water to users within said District. The above Applicant desires to obtain treated water for Applicant's use. The Applicant agrees as follows:

1. The District agrees to provide treated water under the District's Rules and Regulations, as established and amended from time to time hereafter, to the Applicant by use of a fire hydrant meter located at the above location. The location of the fire hydrant meter may not be changed by the Applicant; and the District shall install and remove the fire hydrant meter under this Agreement. The Applicant agrees to pay to the District such sum as may be prescribed from time to time by the Board of Directors as the water rate or charge for such water service. A deposit shall be paid by Applicant to District on the date of this Agreement in the amount established by the District. A minimum payment, as prescribed in the rates of the District, shall be due and payable regardless of water use.

2. The District shall shut off or discontinue service for account delinquencies or other violations of the District's Rules and Regulations, or for other violations of this Agreement.

3. No water service may be obtained except upon property included within the boundaries of the Northern Colorado Water Conservancy District. Applicant hereby confirms and states under oath and under penalty of perjury that all water purchased

from the District shall be applied to property served within the boundaries of the Northern Colorado Water Conservancy District. Applicant shall not resell any water purchased from the District, and Applicant shall not permit other persons to use water furnished to Applicant under this Agreement.

4. Applicant agrees to abide by such other Rules and Regulations of the District regarding the use of water as may be established from time to time by the Board of Directors. Applicant acknowledges receipt of Rule of the District regarding "Use Of Fire Hydrants For Bulk Water Sales." Applicant shall provide Safety Equipment specified by OSHA requirements when entering, operating, and using the hydrant and meter.

5. The undersigned person is personally liable for the performance of the Applicant under this Agreement.

6. Except to the extent of District's willful misconduct, and to the fullest extent permitted by law, Applicant agrees to indemnify, hold harmless, protect, and defend District and District's agents, employees, representatives and contractors from and against any and all claims, causes of action, liabilities, losses, costs, damages, whether foreseeable or unforeseeable, arising out of or related to any act, omission or neglect of Applicant or Applicant's agents, employees, representatives and contractors, or arising from or related to Applicant's use of or activities on or about the operation of the

hydrant and meter. Any water sold to Applicant is sold "as is" and without warranties of any kind whether express or implied; and District specifically disclaims any implied warranty of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose. Applicant waives all claims of damage against District of any kind or nature arising from the sale of water under this Agreement, including consequential and punitive damages. The provisions of this Section 6 shall survive the termination, cancellation or expiration of the Agreement.

7. District shall have the right to terminate this Agreement at any time upon notice to Applicant prior to the termination date specified in the Agreement. Applicant shall pay any rates, fees and costs to the date of termination. Applicant shall pay any and all of the District's attorneys fees and costs of any kind or nature in the event of a breach of this Agreement by Applicant. Applicant may not assign or transfer all or any part of this Agreement.

\*\*\*\*. USE OF FIRE HYDRANTS FOR BULK WATER SALES. The District permits the use of fire hydrants for bulk water sales to current customers (tap holders) or to the general public subject to the provisions contained in the Rules and Regulations of the District.

\*\*\*\*.01 An individual or entity that desires to purchase bulk water from a District fire hydrant shall contact the District to make arrangements for the delivery of a hydrant meter. The Applicant shall sign the standard form of agreement with the District regarding the use of the fire hydrant and fire hydrant meter. The Applicant shall pay a cash deposit at the time of delivery of the hydrant meter in the amount established by District management. The Applicant shall pay for all water used from the District's system at the rate established by the District.

\*\*\*\*.02 The deposit may be refunded after the hydrant and meter have been inspected by a District representative. If either the meter or the fire hydrant is damaged or misused, the cost of the repairs will be deducted from the deposit. If the deposit is insufficient to cover the expenses, including water used, the bulk use customer shall pay the difference.

\*\*\*\*.03 All water purchased by the bulk use customer shall be used within the boundaries of the Northern Colorado Water Conservancy District; and the bulk use customer shall swear under oath that such use will occur.

\*\*\*\*.04 The bulk use customer shall follow the fire hydrant use and set up requirements of the District as provided in the District's Rules and Regulations.
